- 6 Care for your child's safety and happiness
- 7 Let you know about school activities
- 8 Encourage your child in developing a sense of responsibility and consideration towards others.
- 9 Will not tolerate any discrimination on grounds of race, gender, or ability.

- 1 Make sure the child arrives at school on time and with the appropriate equipment
- 2 Discuss with the school any concerns that affect my child's work or behaviour
- 3 Support my child in home learning activities
- 4 Support the school's behaviour policy and code of conduct
- 5 Make sure my child wears school uniform
- 6 Read letters sent home from school and attend parents' evenings to discuss my child's progress
- 7 Contact the school to advise of reasons for absence by 9.30 on the morning of any absence
- 8 Endeavour to ensure my child attends school each day of the school term
- 9 Support the school in not tolerating any form of discrimination on grounds of race, gender or ability

- 2 Work hard at my literacy and numeracy targets
- 3 Talk at home about what I learn at school
- 4 Do all my home activities
- 5 Not miss school and always try to be on time
- 6 Wear my school colours and follow the dress code

- 8 Be polite and helpful to other pupils and grown ups
- 9 Always try to enjoy school and help other children to do the same
