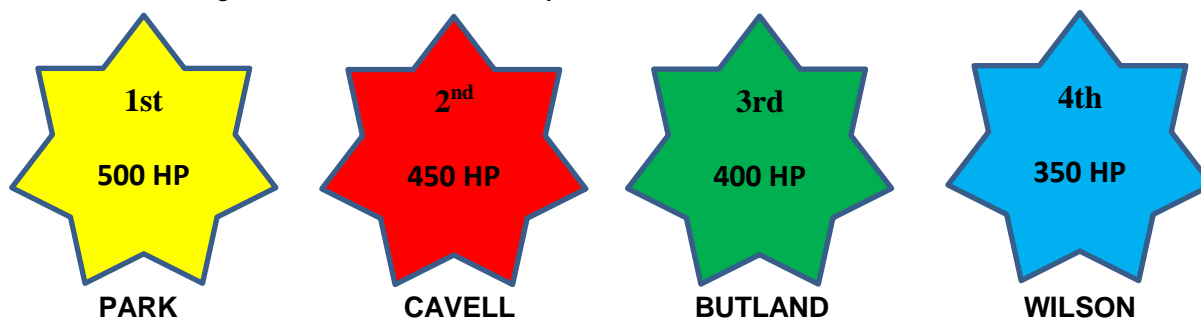

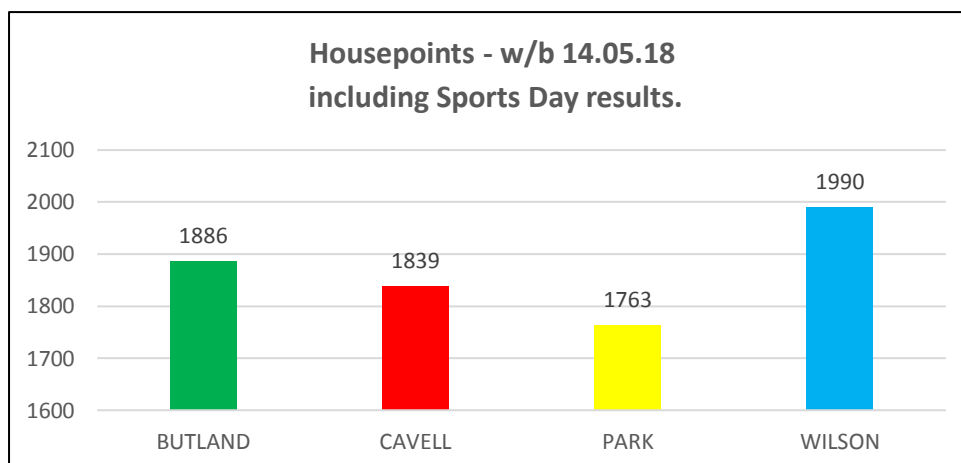

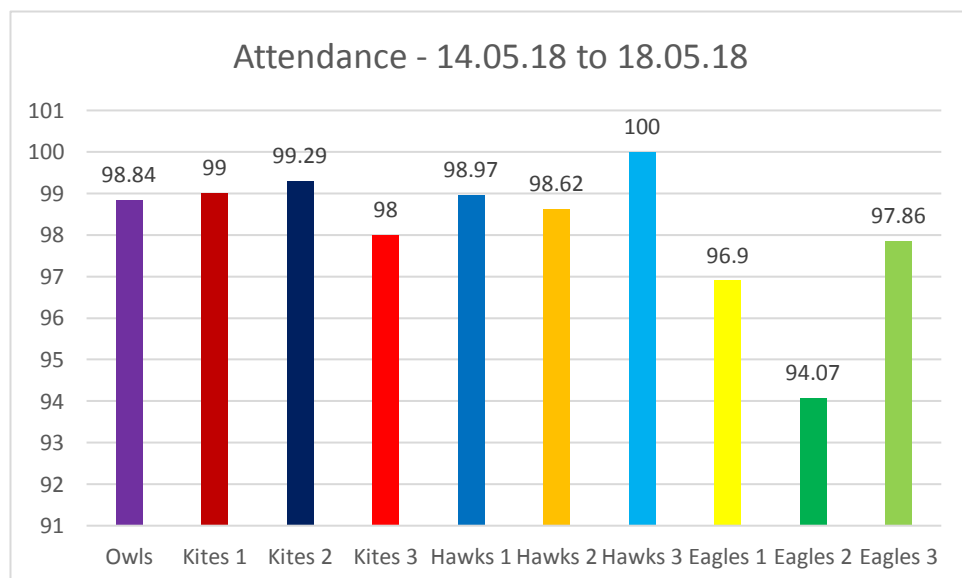
- Admission 2018 pre-school information return deadline is tomorrow (Friday 25<sup>th</sup> May 2018)
