*Earth Class have the opportunity to visit the University of Bath to work with and learn from university academics and those*





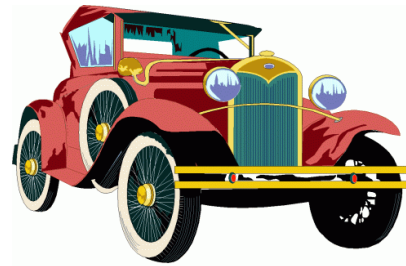
